Advanced glass fusing II: Glass sculpture

July 8–11 | 10 am–4 pm \$435

The beauty of creating sculpture with glass comes from the ability to control the material using the heat in the kiln. Using kiln-safe molding materials and will products, students carve, capture and form shapes using System 96 glass, clay, mold hardener, plaster, casting wax, powder and Kaiser Lee board. Students will learn the techniques of draping, dropping, casting and damming. Students will create six finished pieces exhibiting the techniques taught during the class. Lunch included each day. This 3-day advanced workshop is for those fusers ready to enter the realm of architectural fused glass. Thick cast glass creations make wonderful tabletops, sculptures awards, and much more! Participants will create three 6-inch x 6inch x 1-inch glass blocks exploring three different methods: kiln melting, stack firing and the threedimensional puzzle. This workshop will look at the challenges involved with minimizing bubbles, the techniques of fiber damming and cold working. Lunch included each day. All materials and firing included.
