A414 | Advanced fusing: Georgia falls

Tuesday, July 11, to Friday, July 14, 2017 10 am-4 pm | Fee: \$695 + HST + 96 COE glass



Registration is limited to six people

Join Melanie and Elizabeth on a field trip to the Art Gallery of Ontario and explore the vibrant work of renowned artist, Georgia O'Keeffe, and enjoy an exhibit-inspired prix fixe lunch. Back in Studio, participants will spend three days designing and creating a dramatic fountain of flowers and leaves that can adorn their space whether indoors or out.

Participants will explore the use of Durafibre, fibre rigidizer, and clay to create unique shapes and profiles for the water to cascade over their glass creations. Mold fabrication, multi-layered firing, and water feature creation will also be covered.

AGO admission, clay, fibre, glass accessories, water pump, and all lunches are included.

G212 | Glass flowing: Play day

Tuesday, July 18, 2017 10 am-4 pm | Fee: \$225 + HST

Keep it hot this summer with a day of glass flowing. Participants will explore all the ways we can use our kilns to superheat glass into super cool shapes and kaleidoscope patterns. These unique creations can be incorporated into stained and fused glass projects or enjoyed just as they are.

Using 96 COE glass, participants will learn how to pull their own stringers and cane from the vitrigraph kiln, prepare terracotta for pot melts, create Durafibre dams for screen melt collection as well as experience glass combing in the mini kilns.

I378 | Stained glass sculpture: Canada 150 landscape

Thursday, July 20, and Friday July 21, 2017

10 am-4 pm | Fee: \$225 + HST + stained glass



Celebrate our Canadian landscapes in sculptural stained glass! Show off that sheet of stained glass you've been saving as a stunning backdrop for your multi-layered foiled and soldered sculpture. During this two-day mini-camp, participants will create a three-layer horizontal or vertical landscape depicting trees, rocks, hills, lakes, and maybe even a canoe, using stained glass and wire.

Design techniques, Tiffany plating, and stand creation will also be covered. Participants will create a 12-inch x 16-inch scene.

Lunch, foil, solder, and wire included.

Fall preview:

Calling all beginners!

Here's your chance to sample the various forms of art glass. Creating a multiple of projects over six weeks, you will gain the skill and the confidence to venture on your own.







B220 | Beginner fusing, mosaic, and stained glass: Art glass exploration

Thursdays, September 21, 28, October 5, 12, 19, and 26, 2017 7–10 pm | Fee: \$325 + HST Learn how to safely break and shape glass while creating a stained glass sun catcher that will be copper foiled and soldered.

Explore glass fusing using 96 COE glass and accessories. Make and fire cabochons in the mini kilns. Use glass powder, frit and stringers to create a 4-inch x 6-inch glass landscape.

Complete the exploration in art glass by creating a traditional 12-inch x 16-inch mosaic mirror.
