Glasstronomy Studios' 2018 summer program offers three weekday camps that cover two and three consecutive days.

Glasstronomy Studios hosts workshops for glass enthusiasts with varying levels of experience. Our camp calendar includes something for everyone. Most of our memberships levels qualify for discounts on our camps.

Each camp has a unique number assigned to it that also indicates the level of experience required. Please consider these designations when you register:

- G** – general — all levels welcome
- I** – intermediate level — must know how to safely handle standard glass tools
- A** – advanced level — must have participated in a Studio intermediate level fusing workshop or course

Note: Unless otherwise specified, all materials and firings are included in the listed fees. Studio tools will be provided for participants' use but must be returned to the instructor at the end of each day of their camp.

Upon payment and registration HST will be added to the listed fee.

Advanced fused glass wall sculpture: Fence floral

Date: Tuesday, July 10, to
Thursday, July 12, 2018 (three-day)

Time: 10 am–4 pm

Fee: \$595 + HST + 3.5 sq. ft. of 96 COE fusing sheet glass

Registration is limited to six people

Using 96 COE fusing glass, durafibre, and accessories, participants will create three, 6-inch by 24-inch textured panels, wired leaves, and butterflies in a 30-inch by 30-inch mirror backed, wall mounted sculpture.

Vitrigraph use and multi-layered firing will also be covered.

What is included? Lunch daily, glass base and glass accessories, mirror, high-fire wire, all firings, and custom iron sculpture frame are included.

What is *not* included? Participants will need to bring or purchase 96 COE sheet glass for the flowers and leaves, approximately 3.5 square feet. Bring your own dichroic glass if you choose to add some bling.

Stained glass: Freestyle lamp shade

Date: Tuesday, July 17, to
Thursday, July 19, 2018 (three-day)

Time: 10 am–4 pm

Fee: \$295 + HST + base

Registration is limited to six people

Learn how to freestyle your stained glass leftovers into beautiful shades that will catch the eye all year round.

Participants will learn how to create their own three-dimensional lamp forms while using our stained glass treasures to create the shape of shade they choose. Fabulous and functional options include a 10-inch by 4-inch **cylinder**, 4-inch by 10-inch four-sided **cuboid**, or a 6 to 8-inch diameter **globe**.

Participants will learn how to apply glass to an irregular form, bridge solder, and add lighting to their finished pieces.

What is included? Lunch daily, all glass, chemicals, one roll of copper foil, and 1 lb. of solder are included.

What is *not* included? Base and light bulb are not included.

Fusing fun: Fused glass landscape

Date: Wednesday, July 25, and
Thursday, July 26, 2018 (two-day)

Time: 10 am–4 pm

Fee: \$350 + HST

Registration is limited to six people

Explore the various ways glass powder and frit can be pre-fired and then layered to create various stunning fused glass landscapes. Using 96 COE glass, frit, and powder, participants will create frittage, glass impasto, vitrigrph and many more landscape elements. Once fired, the one-of-a-kind materials will create an 8-inch x 10-inch fused glass landscape displaying both depth and texture in its 11-inch x 16-inch black frame.

Beginners are welcome.

What is included? Lunch daily, all materials, kiln firings, and frame are included.
