**Note:** Unless otherwise specified, all materials and firings are included in the listed fees. Studio tools will be provided for participants' use but must be returned to the instructor at the end of each day of their camp.

Upon payment and registration HST will be added to the listed fee.

### Sculptural stained glass: Panoramic driftwood and glass landscape

Date: Tuesday, July 9, and  
Wednesday, July 10, 2019 (two-day)  
Time: 10 am–4 pm  
Fee: \$295 + HST + background glass +  
driftwood

*Registration is limited to eight people*

**M**emories of summer in stained glass! For the more adventurous stained glass enthusiast, we offer the opportunity to combine glass and wood in this nostalgic northern inspired landscape. Participants will learn how to design, construct and finish a driftwood base to display wire and solder windswept trees and stunning glass sunsets. Add a tent or canoe and have panorama you will want to jump into!

**What is included?** Lunch daily, chemicals, foil, solder, wire, and some glass are included.

**What is *not* included?** Participants will need to bring or purchase a piece of driftwood, and background sky or seascape stained glass.



## A407

### Advanced stained glass box construction: Large dresser box

Date: Thursday, July 11, and  
Friday July 12, 2019 (two-day)  
Time: 10 am–4 pm  
Fee: \$295 + HST + 3 sq. ft. box glass

*Registration is limited to eight people*

**B**igger IS better, in jewellery boxes too! This two-day workshop is for those who have already made a standard copper foil box and are ready to tackle drawers and dividers. Participants will each make an 8-inch x 12-inch copper foiled box with two levels, a hinged lid, divided compartments, and a pullout drawer. Decorative soldering will also be demonstrated.

**What is included?** Lunch daily, chemicals, solder, foil, and drawer, divider, and accent glass included.

**What is *not* included?** 3 sq. ft. box glass not included.



## I399

### Fusing fun: Giant sunflower stake

Date: Wednesday, July 17, and  
Thursday, July 18, 2019 (two-day)

Time: 10 am–4 pm

Fee: \$395 + \$175 glass package (optional)  
+ HST

*Registration is limited to eight people*

**N**o flower says summer like the *Sunflower!* Using 96 COE glass and accessories, participants will create three sculptural sunflowers: 9-inch, 11.5-inch and 13-inch, that will be installed on a six-foot stake adorned with metal leaves. Participants will learn how to stack and texturize using durablanket to create single firing sculptural flowers ready to mount.

**What is included?** Lunch daily, 96 COE accessories, fibre material, kiln firings, and stake are included.

**What is *not* included?** Glass (optional package is available for purchase at time of registration).

### Fusing fun: Sunflower birdbath

Date: Friday, July 19, 2019 (one-day)

Time: 10 am–4 pm

Fee: \$295 + \$125 glass package (*optional*)  
+ HST

**A**tract your feathered friends to your sunflower spa! Made with 96 COE glass and accessories, this dynamic 20-inch sunflower will add a splash to your summer garden. Participants will learn how to prepare duraboard drop out moulds, durablanket texture, and vitrigraph stringers

*Beginner fusers are welcome. Glass cutting skills required.*

**What is included?** Lunch, fibre materials, kiln firings, some glass, and stake are included.

**What is *not* included?** Glass (optional package is available for purchase at time of registration).
