

Spotlight | Makers' market Show and sale

Call to entry

Artists and crafts people in the GTA are invited to participate in our first **Spotlight** | **Makers'** market.

Conditions

Non-members – Non-glass artists are welcome. Please complete the *General maker* registration form and submit it via email or in person by **Tuesday, June 11, 2019. Please submit two photos of your** *original* **work at time of registration.**

Fee: \$25 + HST (payment due upon registration either in person or by phone: cash, debit, MasterCard, Visa)

Members – You must be a member in good standing when you register. Please complete the *Member maker* registration form and submit it via email or in person by **Tuesday, June 11, 2019.**

Squared off challenge – All members are invited to participate in the Squared off exhibit that will be displayed during the Makers' market. Submit a 6-inch square piece in your preferred glass medium to be wall mounted. The theme for the Squared off display is **LANDSCAPE**. Submissions are due on or before Saturday, June 8, 2019. When you submit your piece, let us know if it is for sale and for how much, and if you choose to donate the proceeds to the Yellow Brick House.

Display – Limited indoor space is available, first come, first served. If you are using the outdoor space, you must have your own payment system, table, and awning/tent. If you choose to sell your work through the Studio credit card payment system there will be a 10% surcharge to cover Studio costs.

Criteria

Participants are encouraged to display seasonal work.

Display

Inside the Studio, Participants are limited to one hanging item; and unless otherwise specified, remaining pieces will be displayed on a two-foot wide table surface.



Participants will be provided with a signage with their name and name of their display (if applicable).

Due to space constraints, participation is based on first come, first served availability.

Set up / take down

In Studio set up – Items can be set up on Friday, June 14, 2019, from 1 to 5 pm, and should be taken down after 3 pm on Saturday, June 15, 2019.

Exterior set up – Tents and items can be set up on Saturday, June 15, 2019, from 9 to 10 am, and should be taken down after 3 pm on Saturday, June 15, 2019. We will allocate space for your tent/booth.

Member volunteers needed

Our student and member volunteers will be making glass pendants on Sunday, May 26, 2019, which the students will sell at a booth at the Makers' Market. All proceeds from the cash sale of the pendants will go to Yellow Brick House, a shelter in Richmond Hill. *The Glassed Over Project* collection will be sold via silent auction during the day. A portion of its sale will also go to the Yellow Brick House. In either case, volunteers are needed to oversee the youth and help with the auction.
