Levels of experience

Glasstronomy Studios hosts workshops for glass enthusiasts with varying levels of experience. Our workshop calendar includes something for everyone. While most of our membership levels qualify for discounts on our workshops and courses you *do not* need to be a member to participate. Each workshop has a unique number assigned to it that also indicates the level of experience required. Please consider these designations when you register:

G – general — all levels welcome

B – beginner level (no glass cutting experience required)

I – intermediate level — must know how to safely handle standard glass tools

A – advanced level — must have participated in an applicable Studio intermediate level workshop or course

Payment registration: To register, we currently accept payment in person (cash, Debit, MasterCard, and Visa), by email (etransfer), or by phone (MasterCard and Visa). Please note that HST will be added to the listed fee at time of payment.

*Advanced fusing:
Making one-of-a-kind sheet glass*

When: Thursdays, March 2, 9, 16, and 23, 2023, from 7 to 10 pm
Fee: \$425 + HST + Firing of finished piece

Are you ready to elevate your finished work to one-of-a-kind? Then it's time to make or make more of your very own sheet glass! The beauty of glass fusing is in its versatility, its room for creative expression, and signature style. Using 96 COE accessories and Glassline paint, participants will create 6 square feet of unique sheet glass demonstrating techniques like impasto, powder migration, sgraffito, stamping, stenciling, and paint washes, as well as recreating old favourites like confetti, chopsticks, and mardi gras glass. After three sessions of experimenting, participants will return to cut and shape their one-of-a-kind material into fused glass vessels of their choosing. As shape and size will vary, the final firings are à la carte.

*All material and sheet glass firing included.
Finished piece firings **not** included.*

When: Saturdays, March 4, 11, and 18, 2023, from 10 am to 4 pm
Fee: \$325 + HST + Sheet glass (optional)

The beauty of light shining through glass has inspired us through the ages. The three-dimensional effect of glass fusing adds a unique touch to a traditional favourite. During this multi-disciplinary three-day course, participants will learn how to cut and shape glass, copper foil and solder, as well as fuse three feature pieces to create 9-1/2-inch diameter round window panel. Basic fusing principles of glass compatibility and layering using 96 COE glass and accessories will also be covered. Several patterns of varying difficulty are available.
